### WELCOME & CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT REVIEW

Dr. Rudd called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Dr. Rudd provided a review of the PBMAS plan, the strategies that were decided upon, and where we are in the process for student learning. The VIA PBMAS Improvement Report for Quarter 2 (Nov, Dec, Jan) was provided as a handout. The committee worked in three teams.

- Each quarter was given a set of interventions. We are in the second quarter.
- The committee discussed the use of data regarding the four categories: ELL, CTE, NCLB, and Special Education.
- Areas of needs for improvement are ELL, CTE and SPED.
- Many of the tasks have already been performed.
- There is a reduction of students at LVHS that are EOC retesters.
- ELL table shows evidence of what has been completed.
  - Goals for each of the three areas are listed on the handout.
  - Evidence is listed in the left column.
- Each team needs to talk through each goal, evidence, and the overall plan to determine if anything needs to be adjusted or amended.
- Dr. Johnson provided a sample handout from STRIDE that measures student growth.
- Dr. Johnson assisted the ELL group.
- Dr. Volz assisted the special education group.
- Dr. Rudd assisted the group working with EOC retesters.
