Complete Revisions to the District Improvement Plan (DIP)

Dr. Johnson stated that the goal of today's meeting is to make final revisions to the draft DIP for 2019-2020.

- Revisions are to be easily understood so that it is a usable document.
- Reminders were provided regarding the highlighted items on the DIP strategies that were added as a result of the TEA audit.
- Staffing - To the best of your knowledge, add the persons responsible.
- Evaluations – Include reports, data sources, etc. for the formative and summative evaluations.
- Make clarifications in areas that are not clearly understood.

Share Out – All groups have wrapped up/completed their DIP sections.

- Review Executive Summary to see if anything can be condensed under Priorities. We want a plan that we can actually implement by reducing the list to no more than three items if possible.
- Administrative Inservice is scheduled for next week, April 2-4. Administrative staff will review the plan.
 - Campus administrators will use this district plan to address strategies in their campus plan.
 - The DIP provides the big picture for La Vega ISD and what we plan to do.

Feedback

- It is great to have representatives from each campus.
- Future ease of use – Deal with the formatting piece.
- Dr. Johnson has a template program offered through DMAC (PlanWorks) that was discussed with campus administrators last year. We plan to begin using it for the next school year.
 - Our goal is to get the DIP typed into the new program which requires a lot of typing.
 - You may copy and paste but the features are limited.
 - A cover sheet can be included with graphics (pirate).
 - Formatting is automatic. The district and all campus plans will be uniformed.
 - The template works for us instead of us forcing things into the plan.
